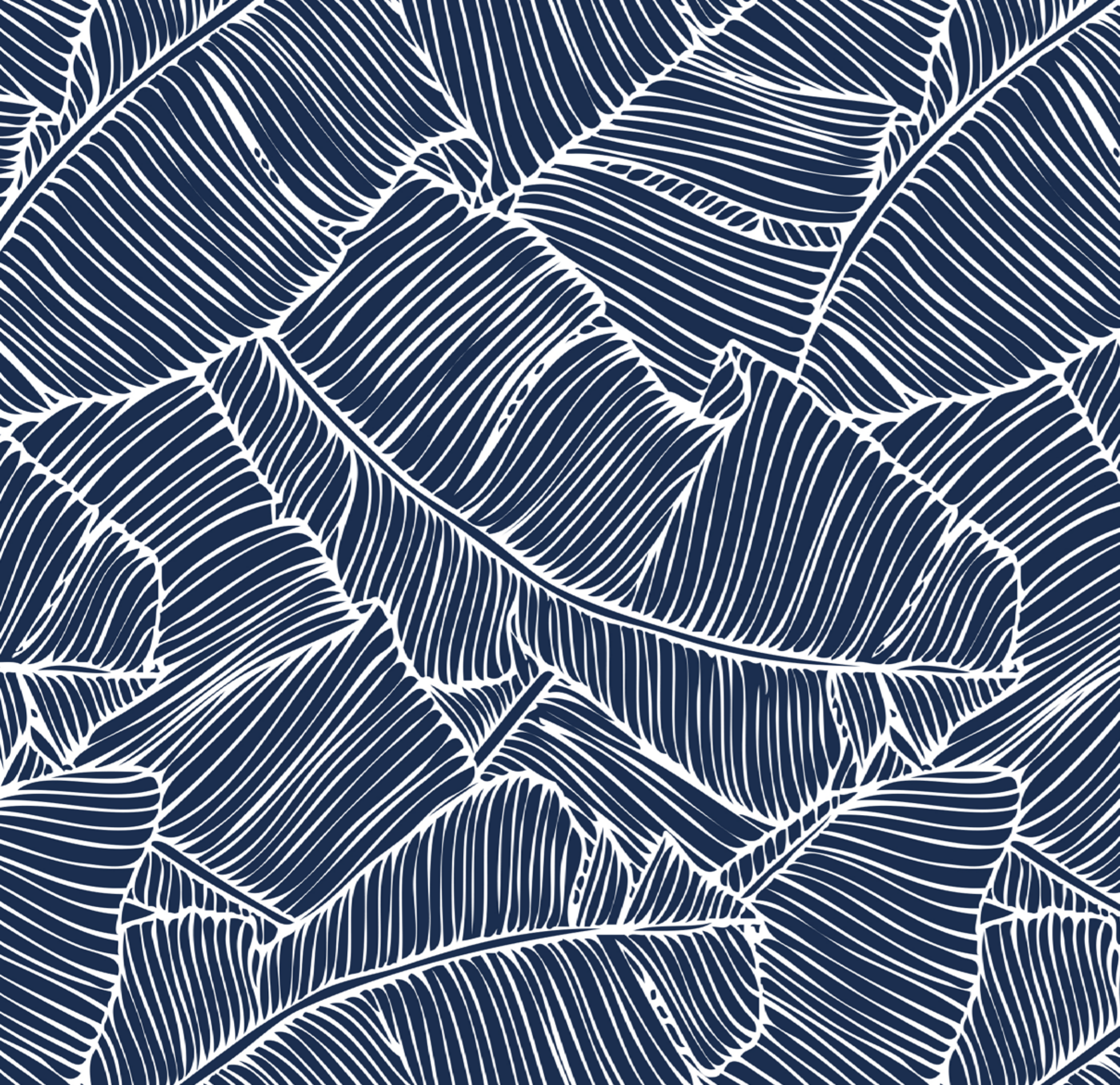

NEW YORK BARN BATH

An antique chair in the master bath of this barn in Amagansett, New York is topped with a cushion covered in a Kravet fabric with tassels by Samuel & Sons.



SOUTH AMERICAN SUNKEN TUB

In Uruguay, this boathouse's sunken tub has views of the lake. The bench is from Zimbabwe, and the room's colors were custom-mixed by Claessens.



WOOD PANELING IN PORTUGAL

In a retreat on an island off of Portugal, the master bathroom sink is locally made, the fittings are by Grohe, the mirror is by Ikea, and the floor is poured concrete.

WINE COUNTRY RUSTIC

An 18th-century wardrobe, an antique Chinese stool and a reclaimed cast-iron tub fill this master bath in California. The lamps and light fixtures by Thomas O'Brien are from Circa Lighting, and the sinks are by Lefroy Brooks.

AN AIRY BATH IN BEVERLY HILLS

The tub by MTI in this Beverly Hills master bath has fittings by Waterworks, the walls are covered in travertine slabs by Walker Zanger, and the flooring is terrazzo.



FRENCH FLAIR

In this Connecticut home, the circa-1850 marble tub is from Water Monopoly, with fittings by Barber Wilsons & Co., in the master bath; the chair is Regency, and the 18th-century vanity is French.





RUSTIC FARM HOUSE ON THE VINEYARD

The children's bathroom in this Martha's Vineyard home is paved in Mexican terracotta tiles, and the tin sconce is from Ball and Ball; the walls and ceiling feature tongue-and-groove and bead-board paneling.



17TH-CENTURY BATH

In this rustic Italian home the powder room's stone sink and brass faucet are antique, the circa-1730 giltwood mirror is Spanish, and the sconces are by Restoration Hardware.



AN OUTDOOR BATH HOUSE IN SOUTHERN FRANCE

The shower walls in this French farm house are reclaimed planks from an 18th-century house, the chair is from Biarritz, France, and the sink is from the 1940s.



MOUNTAIN SPA BATH

A tub by Lefroy Brooks in this master bath in Idaho has fittings by Waterworks; the chandelier is by Lucca Studio, and the Swedish bench is from Sentimento Antiques. The rug by F. J. Hakimian is made of vintage kilims, and the floor is paved in limestone.

RECLAIMED RUSTIC

The photos of mummies were taken on a trip to Egypt by the original owners of this Bedford New York farm; the powder room wall is sheathed in reclaimed wood, and the light fixture is by Schoolhouse Electric.



CITY RUSTIC CHIC

The master bathroom of Alice Childress and Christopher Daniels's downtown Manhattan loft, designed with the help of Courtnay Daniels Haden, includes an antique freestanding marble tub, a vintage Italian chandelier and an inherited 18th-century painting.





SOCAL WITH AN OLD WORLD FEEL

A mural by Jean Horihata in the powder room of a contemporary Southern California residence; the circa-1890 Tramp Art mirror is American, the stool is Chinese, and the sink fittings are by THG.

A DECADENT COPPER TUB

In this Bordeaux, France, home designed by Michael Coorengel and Jean-Pierre Calvagrac, the bathroom's copper tub and fittings are by Herbeau, the 1940s chair is by Jansen, and the linen for the curtains is by Chelsea Textiles.

MEDIEVAL BATH

A zinc bathtub and a tumbled-travertine floor give this guest bath in a converted factory in San Antonio a medieval feel; a marble platter atop an Italian base serves as a table.



CHARMING NORTHERN CALIFORNIA BATH

The master bath tub at this former Northern California summer camp is by Waterworks, the sink and all the fittings are by Lefroy Brooks and the painting is by Hugo Guinness. The walls are painted in Benjamin Moore's White Dove, the floor in Farrow & Ball's All White.



WHITE AND WOOD

This Hamptons retreat, designed by Robert Stilin, intertwines wood and white to create a relaxing, yet rustic, home base. The original tub has fittings by Waterworks and the painting is by Xanda McCagg.



STONE-COVERED MASTER BATH

The tub in the master bath of this Hamptons home is by Waterworks, with fittings by Boffi; the walls are sheathed in reclaimed slate tiles, and the flooring is mahogany.

VINTAGE LA

The master bath in Minnie Driver's Hollywood Hills home features a Venetian mirror, a 1950s bar cart by Mathieu Matégot, and a vintage rug; the flooring is oak and the walls are painted in Benjamin Moore's Navajo White.



CLAWFOOT TUB IN CATSKILLS RETREAT

In Amanda Seyfried's home in the Catskills the master bath's custom vanity has fittings by Waterworks, the sconce is from Design Within Reach, the floor tile is by Heath Ceramics, and the bead-board is painted in Farrow & Ball's Dimpse.

MARRAKESH SHAG RUG

In the living room of Kate and Rem Reynolds' townhouse in Windsor Terrace, Brooklyn, the sofa from ABC Carpet & Home is upholstered in a fabric by Soraya Shah for Studio Four NYC, the design showroom Kate Reynolds co-owns. The Moroccan rug is vintage.





GREAT PLAINS MAVERICK RUG

In designer Patrick Printy's studio, a pair of vintage sofas is upholstered in a Ralph Lauren Home stripe, the Eero Saarinen table is from Design Within Reach, barstools by CB2 are covered in a Katie Ridder fabric, the ceiling lantern is by Visual Comfort, the rug is by Ralph Lauren Home, and the busts are by Oly.

SEA-GRASS RUG

In a Greenwich Village penthouse, the antique Swedish sofa and Baroque chair, are upholstered in Robert Kime fabrics, the armchair is 18th-century French and a vintage Persian Soumak rug from Istanbul's Grand Bazaar rests on a sea-grass rug from ABC Carpet & Home.



A SUNNY MANHATTAN HIDEAWAY

In the same Manhattan apartment, the living room's 19th-century English faux-bamboo chairs and antique French stool are covered in Robert Kime linens, the antique French iron garden-table base is topped with antique marble and a sculptor's stand holds a 19th-century Italian terra-cotta urn.

CHUNKY BRAIDED TWIST RUG

The barn at actress Amanda Seyfried's weekend retreat in the Catskills now serves as guest quarters. In the living room, the sofa is by West Elm, the wool rug is by Restoration Hardware, the flooring is reclaimed oak, and the wall is painted in Benjamin Moore's White Dove. SILK RUG

This living room's circa-1905 Josef Hoffmann chairs are covered in Burmese python, a sculpture by Sol LeWitt serves as a cocktail table and the Wendell Castle pedestal was originally a newel post. The silk rug is by Fort Street Studio and the painting over the mantel is by Ross Bleckner.





TIBETAN RUG

In the main living room of hairstylist Marcos Proença's São Paulo duplex, which was designed by Fabrizio Rollo, both the sofa, upholstered in a Rubelli velvet, and the screen were made in the 1940s by Dinucci.



IVORY AREA RUG

The pristine beige palette of this Palm Beach apartment is anchored by a neutral rug with a thick ivory border, and accented by a glass chair by Jacques Adnet and René Coulon. A 1970s Italian cocktail table is by Gae Aulenti. The concrete wall plaques are by Radu Comsa.

MOROCCAN BERBER RUG

This São Paulo duplex is eclectic and intriguing with an eye-catching Moroccan Berber rug and Jean Prouvé chair by Vitra.



GEOMETRIC GRAY RUG

In a Spanish-inspired London townhouse, jewel tones are juxtaposed against a quiet gray rug – the perfect contrast. The sofa is covered in a Donghia patterned velvet and a round banquette is topped with a 1940s French bronze sculpture.





MOROCCAN BERBER RUG

In the living room of Lisa Pomerantz and Jonathan Copplestone's Manhattan apartment, the Berber rug is vintage.



FUR RUG
