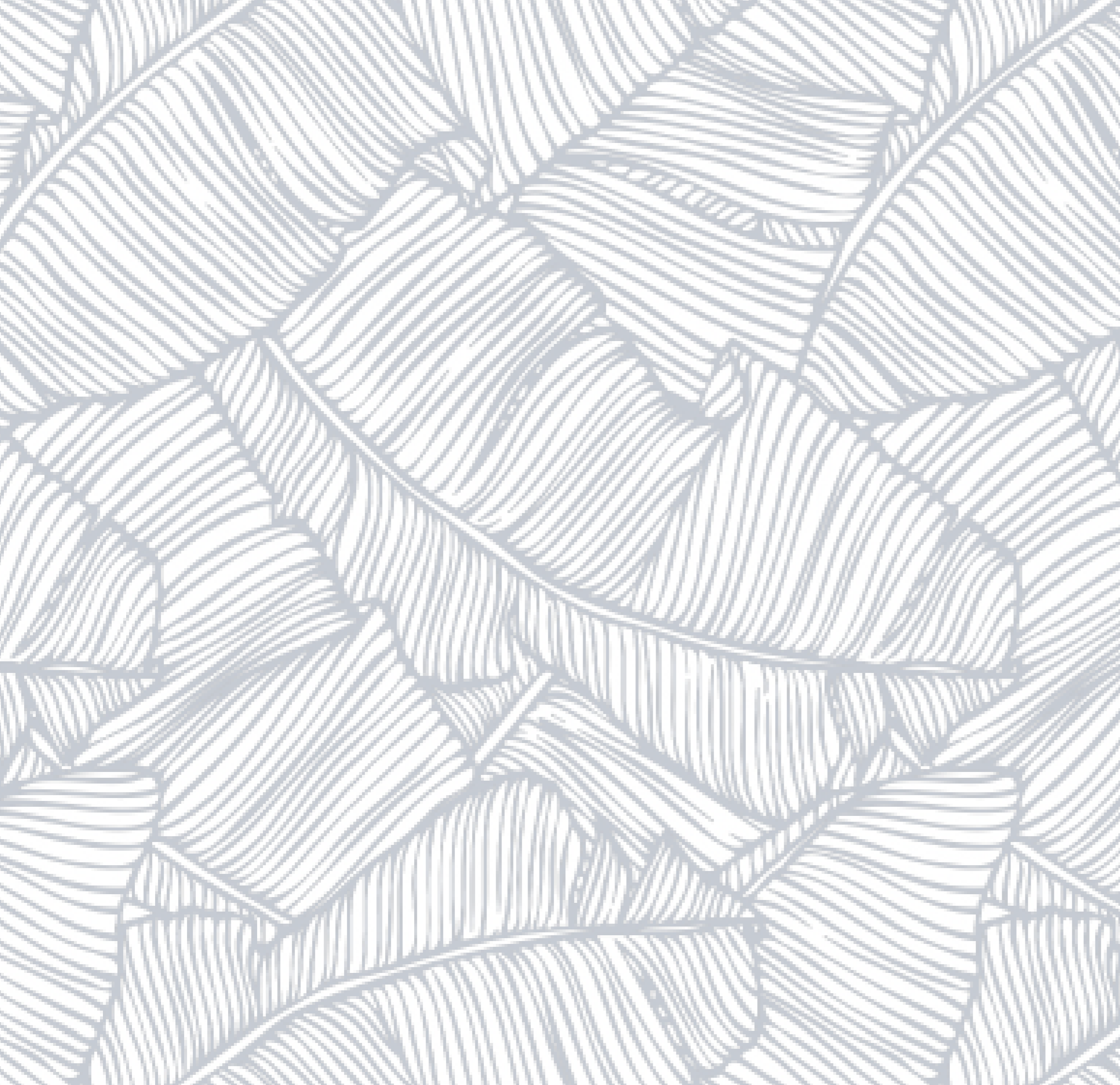

WHITE SOFA IDEAS

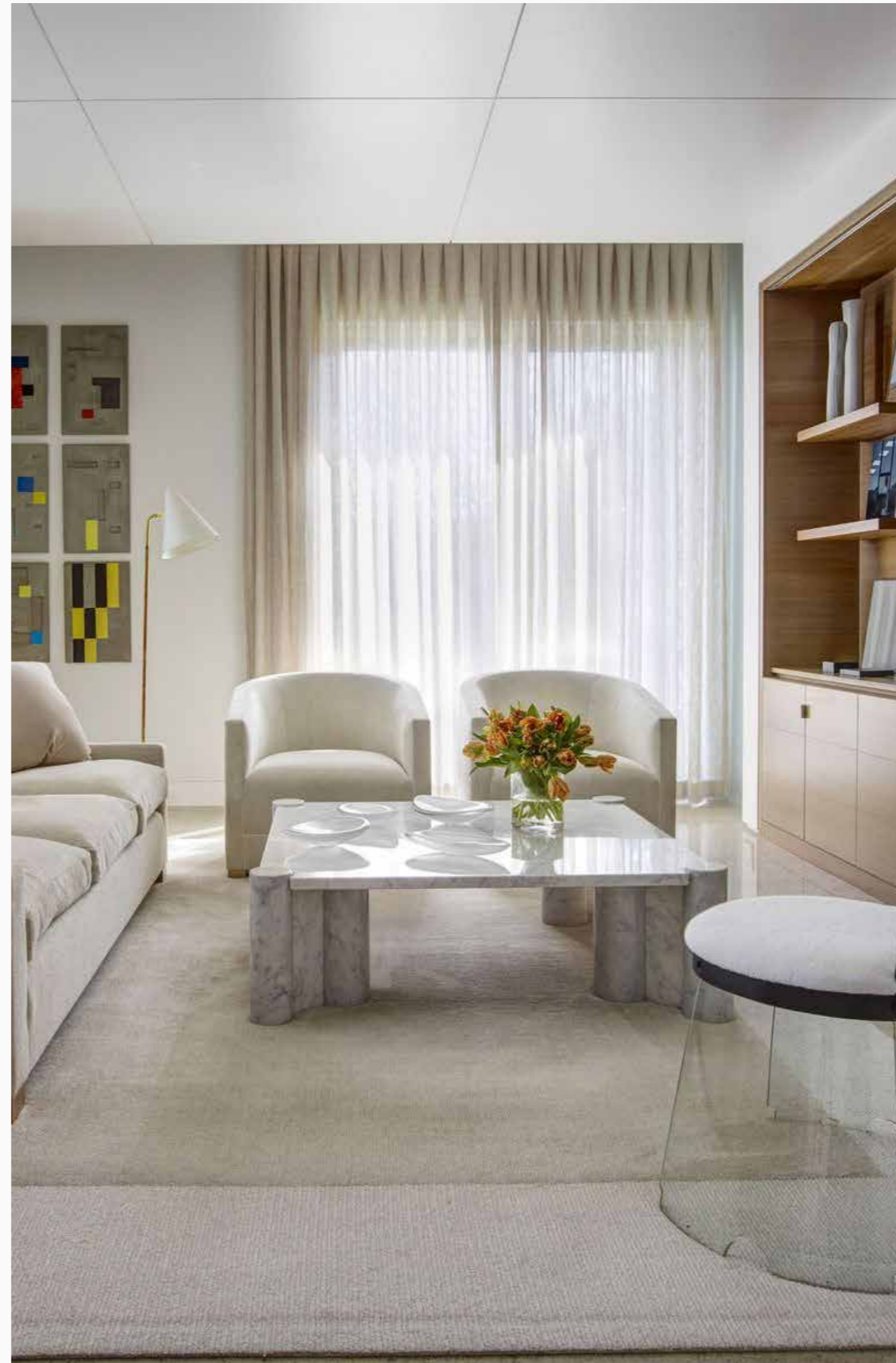
A white sofa is a great anchor. Now, bring it to life with everything else in your living room.





COTTAGE WHITE SOFA

This Ibiza living room features local-limestone floors covered in custom Spanish esparto rugs from Antonia Molina. Walls covered in a sandy lime plaster, and a wood-beam ceiling set a rustic tone in the living room.



ELEGANT WHITE SOFA

The pristine beige palette of this Palm Beach apartment is anchored by a neutral rug with a thick ivory border, and accented by a glass chair by Jacques Adnet and René Coulon. A 1970s Italian cocktail table is by Gae Aulenti. The concrete wall plaques are by Radu Comsa.



TEXTURED WHITE SOFA

In the living room of Kate and Rem Reynolds's townhouse in Windsor Terrace, Brooklyn, the sofa from ABC Carpet & Home is upholstered in a fabric by Soraya Shah for Studio Four NYC, the design showroom Kate Reynolds co-owns. The chaise is by Timothy Oulton, the cocktail table is Danish.



DOUBLE WHITE SOFAS

At a contemporary home in L.A., the living room's sofas are by RH, Restoration Hardware, the 1950s chairs are Danish, the cocktail table is by Charles Hollis Jones, the end tables are from Lucca Home, and the antique stool was a Japanese rice box. The antique mirror is Indian, the mantel is original, the pendant is by Paul Ferrante, the floor lamp is by Visual Comfort, and the sconces are by Ralph Lauren Home.

CLASSIC WHITE SOFA



In this Upper East Side apartment, designer Ann Pyne dressed up white with even more white. The white sofa is paired with a white chandelier in the style of Diego Giacometti and rustic Chinese-style chairs. The marble table is from R.E. Steele Antiques and the floor is painted.



GLAM WHITE SOFA

In the living room of a luxurious Palm Springs house, there are vintage Barcelona chairs, back-to-back sofas by William Haines, an Arco lamp by Achille Castiglioni and a floor lamp by Dragonette. The wall is sheathed in Venetian plaster, the ceiling is cedar and the floors are poured-in place terrazzo.



MODERN WHITE SOFA

Designer Alison Palevsky anchored the white sofa, dotted with bright green pillows, in her Pacific Palisades home with a silk rug from Lawrence of La Brea. A painting by Gottfried Helnwein makes a dramatic appearance next to the French doors that open to the terrace.



BOHEMIAN PILLOWS AND WHITE SOFA

In the living room of Meredith Melling and Zach Iscol's retreat on Martha's Vineyard, designed by Ariel Ashe and Reinaldo Leandro of Ashe + Leandro, the sofa by Restoration Hardware is covered in a Perennials linen and dotted with patterned pillows with bohemian spirit. A custom walnut cocktail table and stool provide an earthy contrast to the crisp white.



MODERN WHITE SOFA

In Clora Kelly and Helge Skibeli's Shelter Island home, a modern white sofa gets a cheery upgrade thanks to citrus-toned pillows (which also help tie in the room's artwork.)

CHENILLE WHITE SOFA



In the living room of philanthropists Ellen and Daniel Crown's Manhattan apartment, the custom-made sofa is covered in a Kravet chenille and complemented with sunny yellow pillows and a blue and white pillow.

DOUBLE WHITE SOFAS

For the blue and white living room in actress Ellen Pompeo's Hollywood villa, the custom-made sofa is cushioned with pillows covered in Indian cotton throws. The Afghan wool dhurrie is from the 1930s, and the candelabra is by Picasso.



WHITE LINEN SOFA

In the den of actor and producer Ellen Pompeo's home, designed by Martyn Lawrence-Bullard, the sectional sofa is upholstered in a white linen by C&C Milano, covered in vibrant pillows and paired with woven-seagrass stools by ABC Carpet & Home. The upholstered screens are all by Martyn Lawrence-Bullard.



COTTON WHITE SOFA

In the living room of an 1870s carriage house, the custom sofa is covered in a Kravet cotton and topped with pillows of various muted hues. The cocktail table is by Martin Szekely, the dhurrie is 19th century and the Egyptian light fixture is from Liza Sherman.





PLUSH WHITE SOFA

In the living room of Mona Nerenberg and Lisa Bynon's Hamptons home, which they designed with Mark Cunningham, the creamy white sofa is by Ralph Lauren Home, as are the armchairs. A rustic cocktail table by Démiurge New York, and the apple-matting rug from Nerenberg's shop, Bloom, in Sag Harbor, New York, add a rustic air to the otherwise prim-and-proper white furniture.



CRISP WHITE SOFA

Fashion designer Lisa Perry started with a completely white palette, including a crisp white sofa by de Sede, in her family's Florida getaway, then added droplets of bright colors and attention-grabbing artworks. The cocktail table is by Cini Boeri and the painting, *Elaidyl Alcohol*, is by Damien Hirst.

TONAL PATTERN

The traditional rug in this New Jersey home continues the tonal design scheme. Deep red throw pillows and flowers add dimension.



VIBRANT COLORS

This Manhattan living room relies on a traditional rug to pull the red, yellow, and blue palette of the room together.



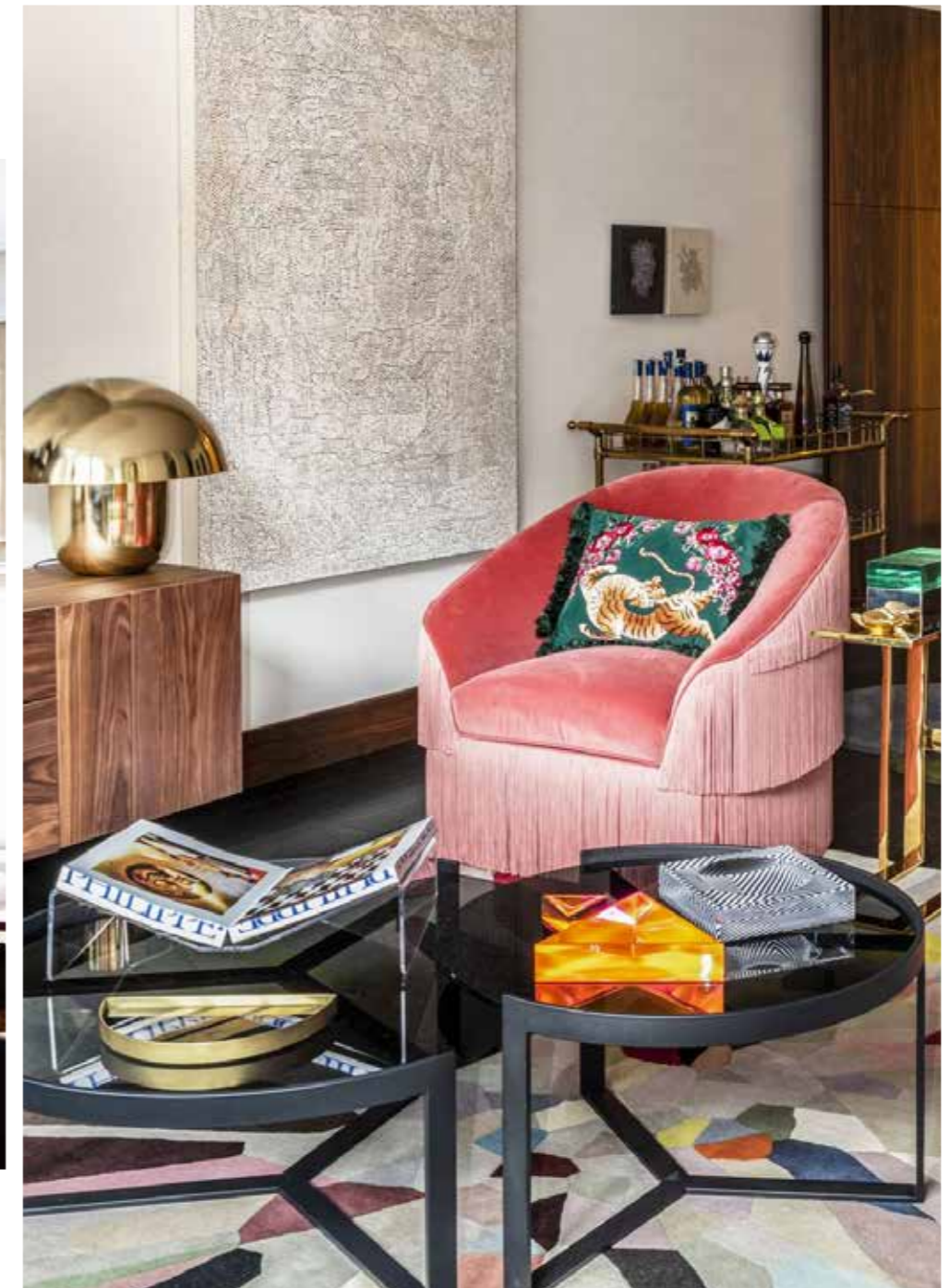
NEUTRAL ABSTRACT PATTERN

An abstract geometric rug complements the curves of the furniture and lighting in this London apartment.

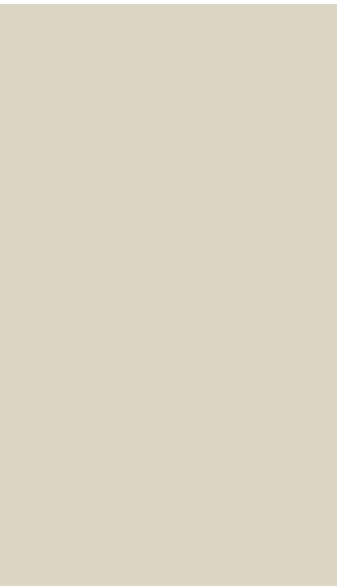


SHEEP-WOOL RUG

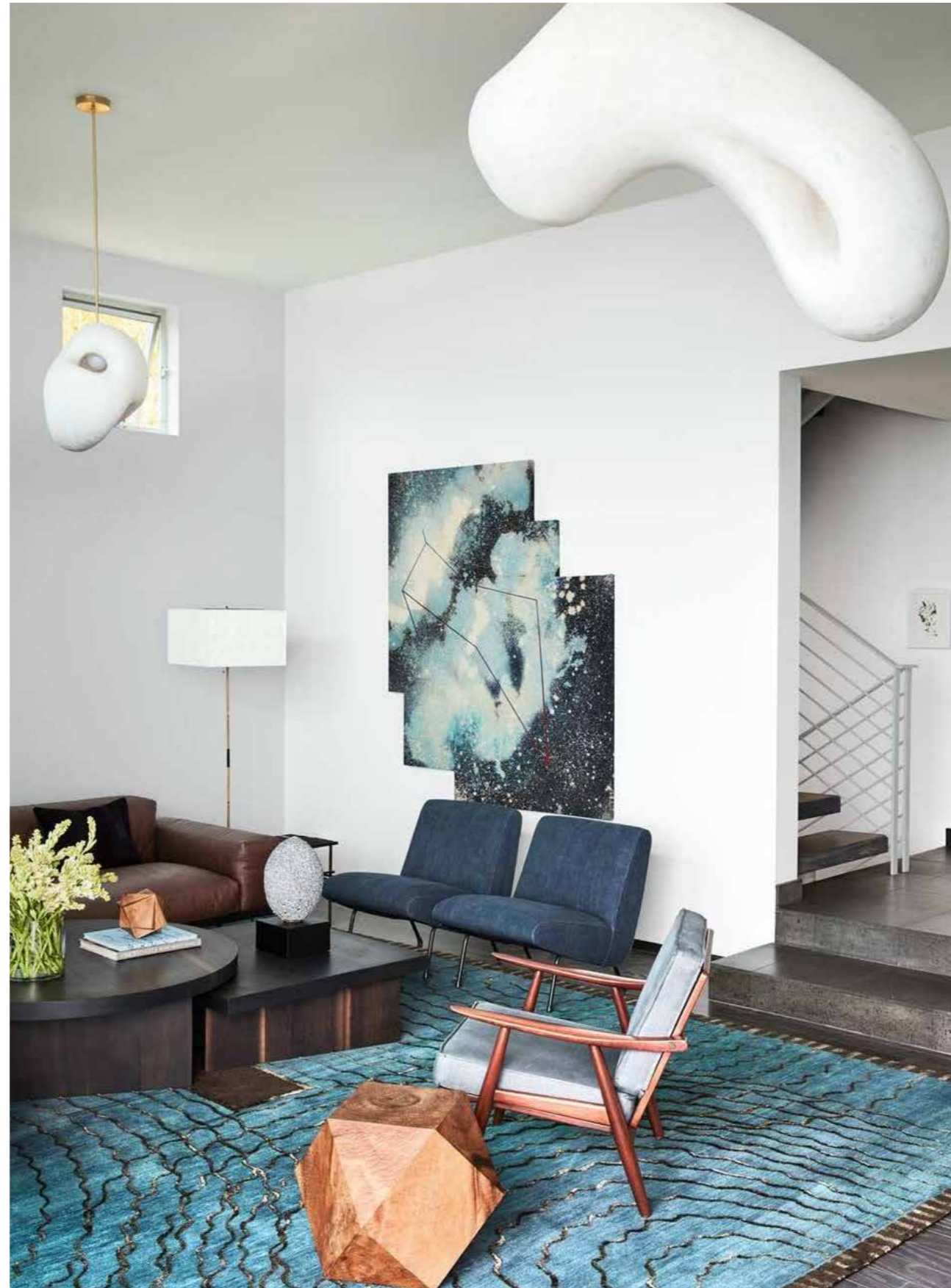
WAVE DESIGN

COWHIDE

Designer Paloma Contreras relied on a cowhide rug, the perfect foundation for a custom cocktail table, to pull this Houston living room together.



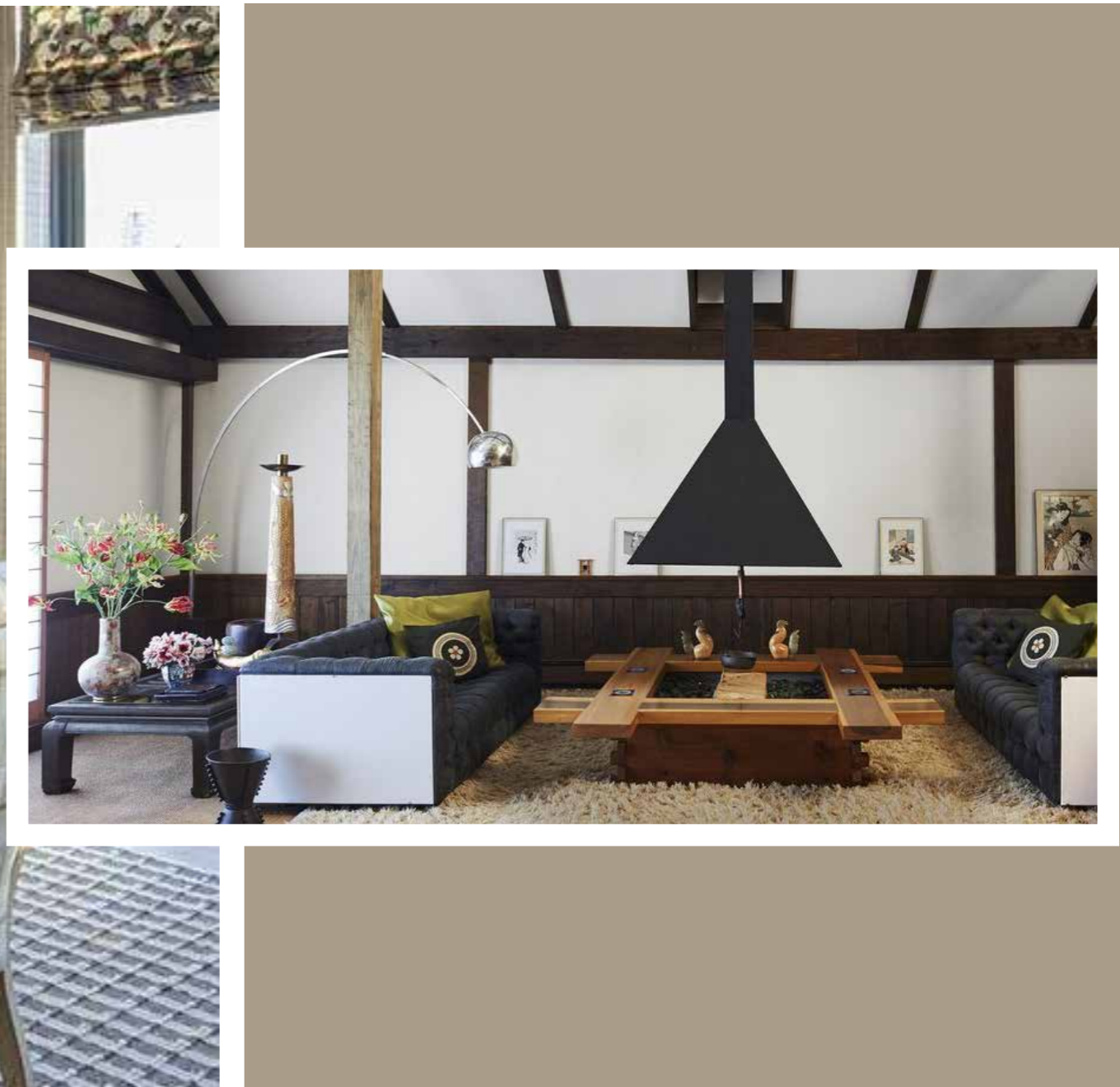
SNAKE RUG

A Kelly Wearstler rug boasting a snake motif is the touch of drama this neutral living room in the Hamptons, designed by Brigette Romanek, required.



GRAY STRIPES

In keeping with this New York living room's neutral palette, interior designer Thom Filicia settled on a custom gray striped rug design from Holland & Sherry.



SHAG ON SISAL

In the living room of Vivia Horn's Japanese-style retreat in Hunter, New York, the leather-and-plastic Italian sofas, cocktail table, and wool shag rug were purchased in the 1980s at Bloomingdale's. The Japanese-style fire pit and tin range hood are custom, the floor lamp is from the '70s, and the sisal carpet is by Stark.

PATTERN ON PATTERN

While not technically a living room—interior designer Carolyn Pressly uses this space as an office—there’s a lot to be learned from her choices.



NAVY PATCHWORK

A houndstooth ottoman is the centerpiece of the living room in this snug New York City bachelor pad; a rug with exposed stitching feels textural and homey.





NATURAL CHEVRON RUG

In a treehouse-style Mexican home, the family room's sofa and ottoman are by Ligne Roset, the Saarinen side table is by Knoll, and the rug is a custom design. The tapestry was created from a traditional Bhutanese man's robe.



SILK RUG

This upstate New York living room has circa-1905 Josef Hoffmann chairs covered in Burmese python, and the silk rug is by Fort Street Studio.

PEACOCK BLUE RUG

In a Manhattan apartment designed by Sasha Bikoff, the 1920s Chinese Deco rug is dyed peacock blue—part of the apartment's goal to merge an old-world aesthetic and a whimsical style.





MARRAKECH SHAG RUG

In the living room of Kate and Rem Reynolds' townhouse in Windsor Terrace, Brooklyn, the sofa from ABC Carpet & Home is upholstered in a fabric by Soraya Shah for Studio Four NYC, the design showroom Kate Reynolds coowns. The Moroccan rug is vintage.



IVORY AREA RUG

The pristine beige palette of this Palm Beach apartment is anchored by a neutral rug with a thick ivory border, and accented by a 1970s Italian cocktail table is by Gae Aulenti.



BLUE TRIANGLES RUG

In this Parisian rooftop apartment, the living room's rug is by Ikea. The armchairs, cocktail and side tables, and sofa are all by Casamidy.

STRIPED BLUE RUG

In the blue-and-white living room of actress Ellen Pompeo's Hollywood villa, the Afghan wool dhurrie is from the 1930s. The custom-made sofa is cushioned with pillows covered in Indian cotton throws.



GEOMETRIC TAN RUG

In the living room of Meredith Melling and Zach Iscol's retreat on Martha's Vineyard, designed by Ariel Ashe and Reinaldo Leandro of Ashe + Leandro, a geometric tan rug echoes the bohemian spirit of the patterned pillows.





BLACK-AND-WHITE RUG

In a Danish couple's weekend retreat, a rug by Caravane and Achille and Pier Giacomo Castiglioni's Arco floor lamp for Flos are in the living room.



BERBER RUG

In the living room of Lisa Pomerantz and Jonathan Coplestone's Manhattan apartment, the Berber rug is vintage.

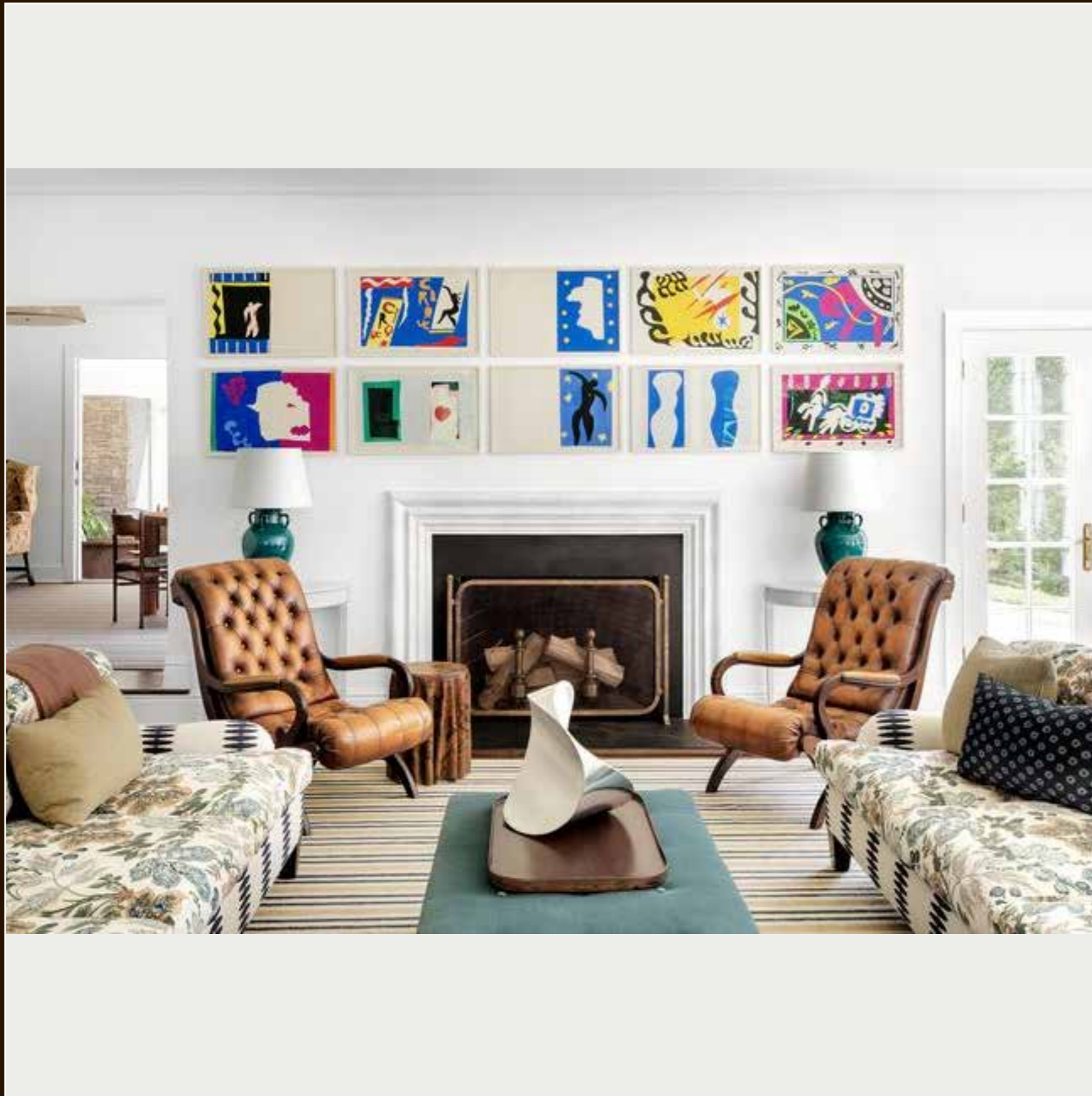

UNDULATING SCULPTURE

Balancing multiple accessories on a tufted ottoman can be tricky, so a pro tip is to anchor a decorative object on a tray. The tray and sculpture shown in this New York cottage are from the Huniford vintage collection.



ORGANIC MODERNISM

Place two tree-like stools side by side in a formal seating area with upholstered furniture to add texture. Leave the tabletop bare except for one small object. Small gray tables break up a vibrant color palette in this Paris apartment.



CONSIDER A GLASS-TOPPED TABLE

When you're aiming to showcase a significant amount of accessories, a cocktail table with a glass top can provide balance. It doesn't take up as much visual space as an all-wood design, for instance, and it keeps the focus on your display.



LEAFLIKE COCKTAIL TABLE

A vintage cocktail table by Wendell Castle shaped like a leaf makes a statement on its own in this Manhattan penthouse. Top it with minimalist accessories, such as a flower-filled urn and low bowl.



GO FROM HIGH TO LOW

On the square cocktail table by Thierry Jeannot, there are four points of interest. Each point varies in height, and a tall flowering plant adds color to the gray design scheme.



ANTIQUÉ COCKTAIL TABLE

In a neutral space with high ceilings, cherry blossoms in a Georg Jensen vase are earthy and airy. They also add height to the low antique Chinese cocktail table in this Palm Beach house.

ADD SOME HEIGHT

A feathery floral arrangement keeps the vibe of this family room nook cozy while adding height and drawing the eye up to the artwork by Zipora Fried. The custom sectional is covered in fabrics by Great Plains and Donghia, the cocktail table by Daniel Scuderi and the chandelier by Trans-Luxe are both custom.



GO FOR ONE STATEMENT PIECE

If the idea of mixing decorative objects, flowers, and books really isn't your style, opt for one statement piece that reflects your personality. An eye-catching sculptural item or vase containing your favorite blooms is sometimes all that's needed to complete a living room design.





MIX RUSTIC WITH REFINED

The cocktail table inside designer Rela Gleason's San Miguel de Allende, Mexico, home is an inverted polished tree stump, and a stone mill wheel serves as a side table. A ceramic vase and a leather-bound book keep the look classic.

WEAVE IN A SENTIMENTAL ITEM

Whether it's a family heirloom or a ceramic you've treasured for years, incorporating a sentimental element into your coffee table decor adds a special touch. Plus, it's the perfect conversation starter, something necessary for every interior.



ACCENT WITH STOOLS

In the living room of a weekend home in Bridgehampton, New York, designed by Steven Gambrel, the cocktail table is by Dos Gallos and topped with several vases and trays. The petite Thebes-style cane stools that accompany it are vintage.

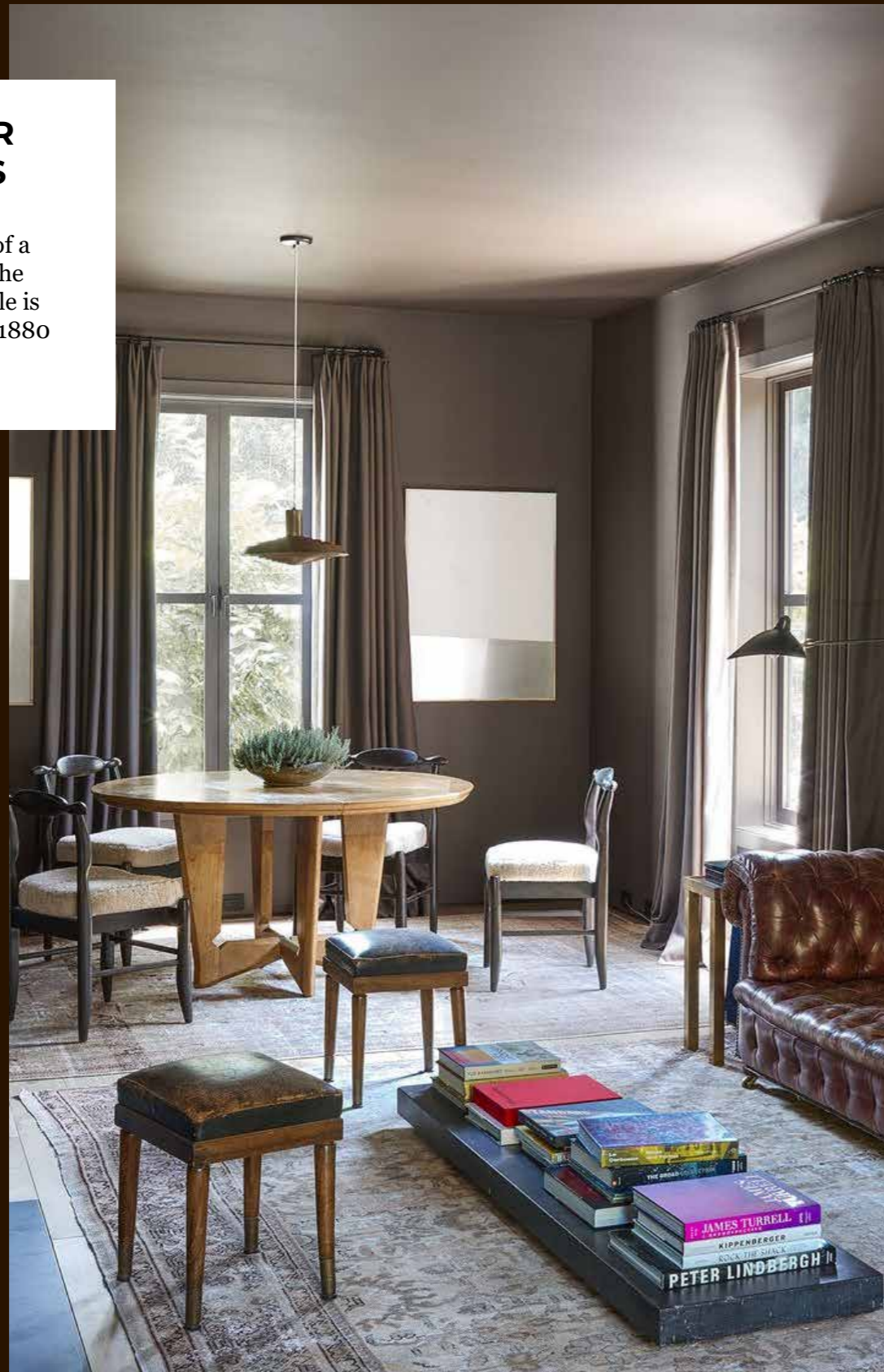


TOP AN OTTOMAN WITH A TRAY

Give your ottoman a makeover by styling a tray on top of it, creating the perfect place to display flowers, candles, and books, like in this Greenwich Village penthouse.

DITCH YOUR TABLE LEGS

In the game room of a Los Angeles home, the unique cocktail table is made from a circa-1880 slate slab.



ACCENT WITH A SINGLE DISH

If your coffee table is tiny in size, like the one in this São Paulo duplex, all it needs is one of your favorite artisan bowls or plates to elevate it—especially if the rest of the room boasts maximalist decor.



DON'T GO OVERBOARD

In the living room of a Paris apartment designed by Jean-Louis Deniot, the black-and-white cocktail table by Hagit Pincovici is a nod to the gray found throughout the rest of the room. To let the piece shine, tabletop accessories are limited to candlesticks and a decorative sculpture.



OPT FOR TWO LONG TABLES

In the living room of hotelier Ian Schrager's New York apartment, two long tables divide the sofas. The visual illusion itself is the decorative piece—simple and effective.



USE TRAYS TO ORGANIZE

It's a no-brainer that trays are an excellent way to stylishly organize a tabletop. In a rustic barn in Amagansett, New York, a wicker tray breaks up the cocktail table and can also be used to serve food and drinks when needed.



DUST OFF YOUR RETRO FINDS

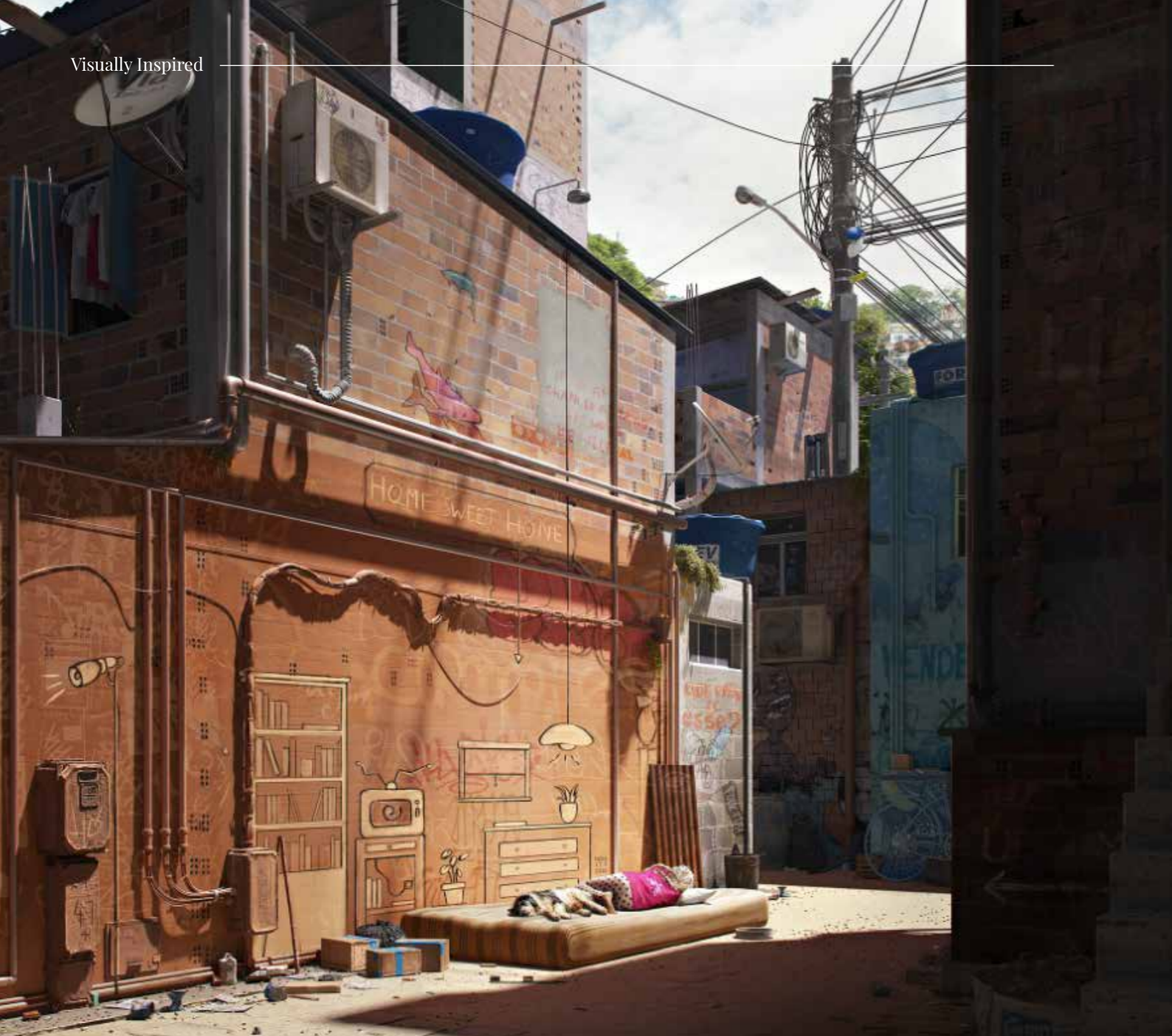
