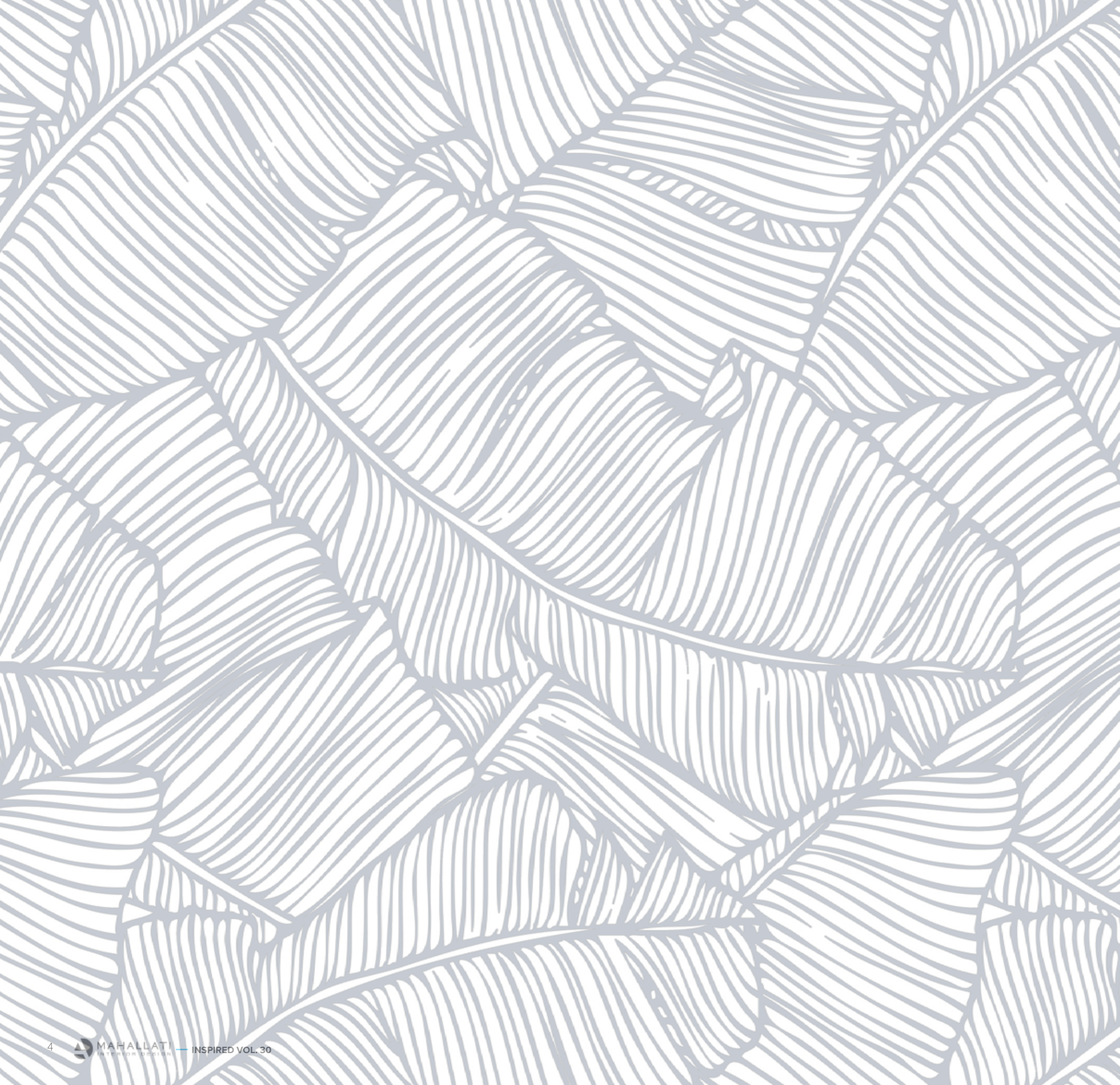

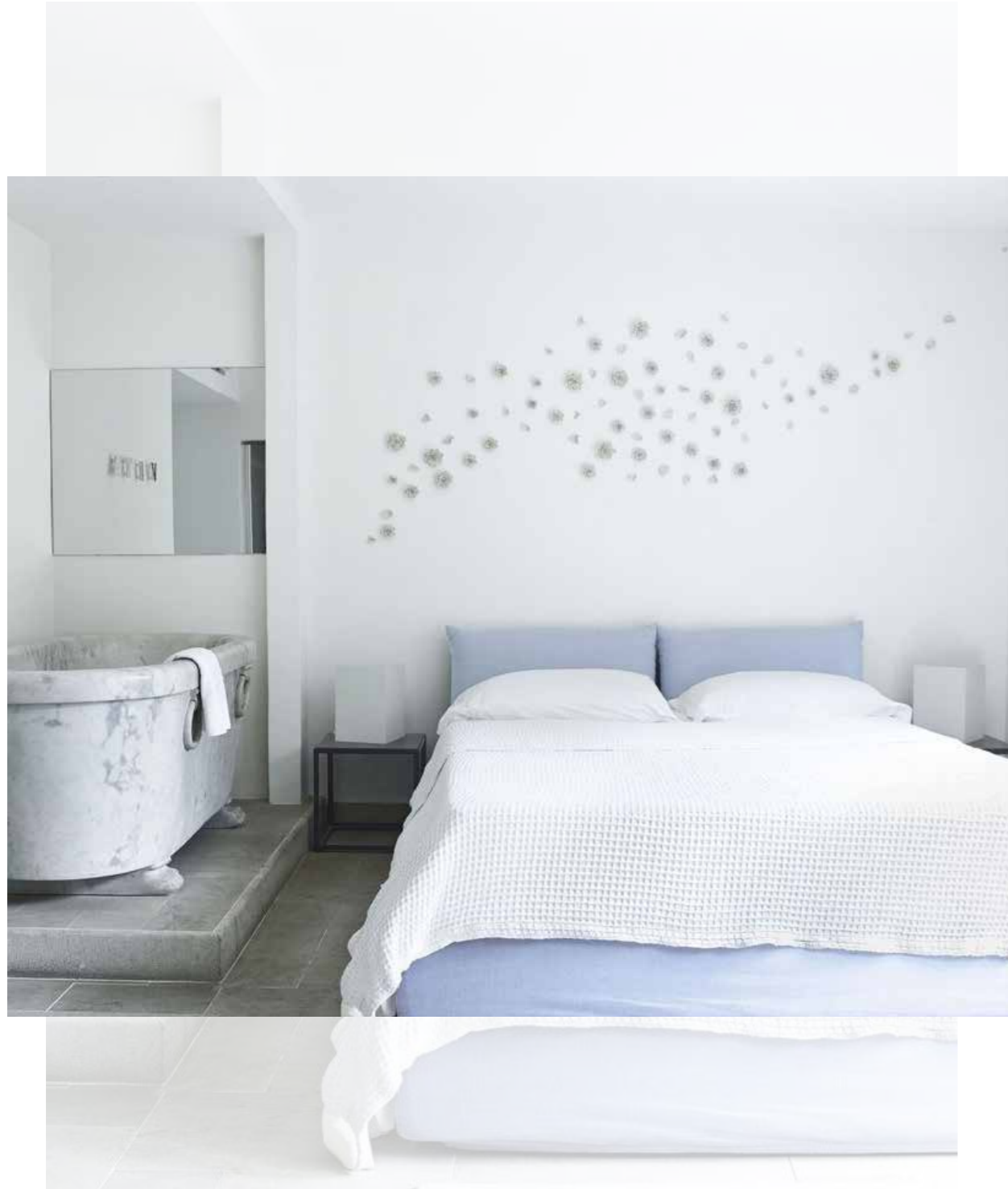

## NATURALLY LIT ATTIC BEDROOM

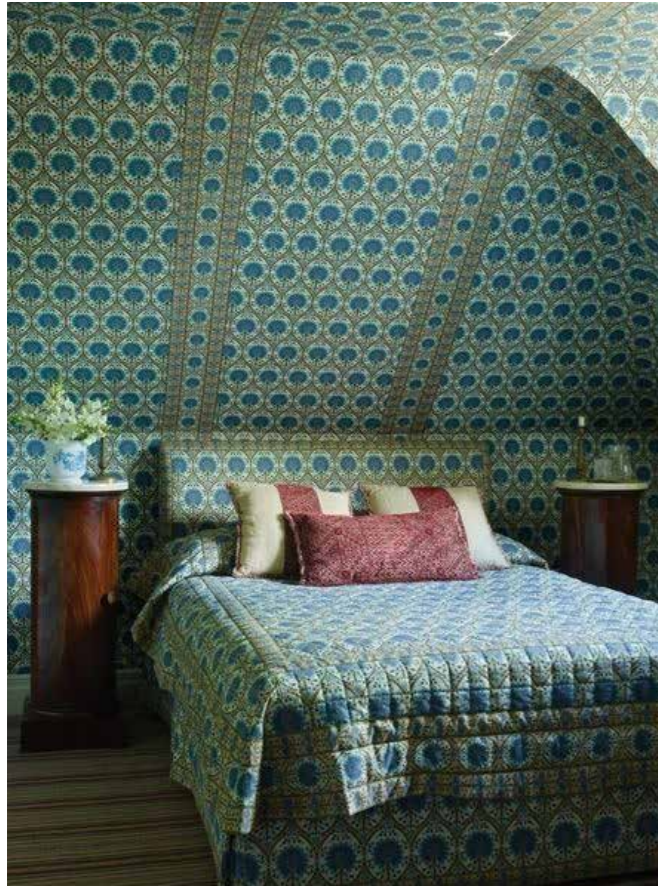

## COUNTRYSIDE MINIMALISM

Earthy tones make two New York designers' Marrakech riad feel cozy rather than cramped. The master bedroom's rug was found in a souk.



## ALL ABOUT STUCCO AND CEMENT TILE

It was love at first sight when artist Eva Claessens and art dealer Kris Chesquière came upon a remote roadside ruin in Uruguay which they then transformed into their dream house. Inside, the kitchen's pendant light is leather, the ceiling beam is an old railroad track found in a nearby field, and the flooring is tinted cement tile.



## SWISS SIMPLICITY

At an Alpine getaway in St. Moritz, the kitchen ceiling and walls are covered in 18th-century Portuguese tiles, the 19th century French table is surrounded by English chairs of the same era, and the light fixture is 19th-century French.





## ELLEN DEGENERES'

In the kitchen area of Ellen DeGeneres and Portia de Rossi's Santa Monica home, an Italian industrial light fixture hangs above an antique bluestone table and 19th-century American Windsor chairs; an Ib Kofod-Larsen armchair and a midcentury Danish lounge chair in its original leather are placed near the fireplace.



## ITALIAN KITCHEN

The elevated Tuscan-style fireplace in this Italian kitchen is original to the home. The chairs are Spanish, and the light fixture was made by Florentine craftsmen.

## LOS ANGELES CONTEMPORARY

In her midcentury Los Angeles house, fashion designer Rozae Nichols carefully preserves a California cool aesthetic with its laid-back vibe and rustic sophistication. Her kitchen features custom redwood cabinetry, a backsplash of penny tiles by Mission Tiles, an oven and dishwasher by Miele, and sink fittings by Vola.





## A NEW YORK CARRIAGE HOUSE

Former Vogue editor, Virginia Tupker, helped her friend redesign an 1870's farm in Bedford, New York for modern day living. The kitchen island is made of a vintage marble slab on a steel base, the stove is by BlueStar, and the shelves are of reclaimed wood found on the farm; the pendant lights are from Rewire, and the floor is concrete.

## CAPE COD COTTAGE

In this Cape Cod cottage, a vintage seascape hangs above an antique butcher block.



## LONDON HOME

The kitchen island in this London home is made from a 19th-century cast-iron stove and topped with Carrara marble; the pendant light is early-20th-century French, and the walls are lined with 19th-century Portuguese tiles.



## SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE

Leslie Tung and her husband, architect Gerard McCormack, renovated a kitchen in San Miguel de Allende, Mexico, that is imbued with a sense of rustic, international flair. The walls are sheathed in Talavera tiles, the floor is paved with stained brick tiles, and the antique farmhouse-style table is surrounded by Casamidy chairs, which are upholstered in a linen by Mitu Atelier.



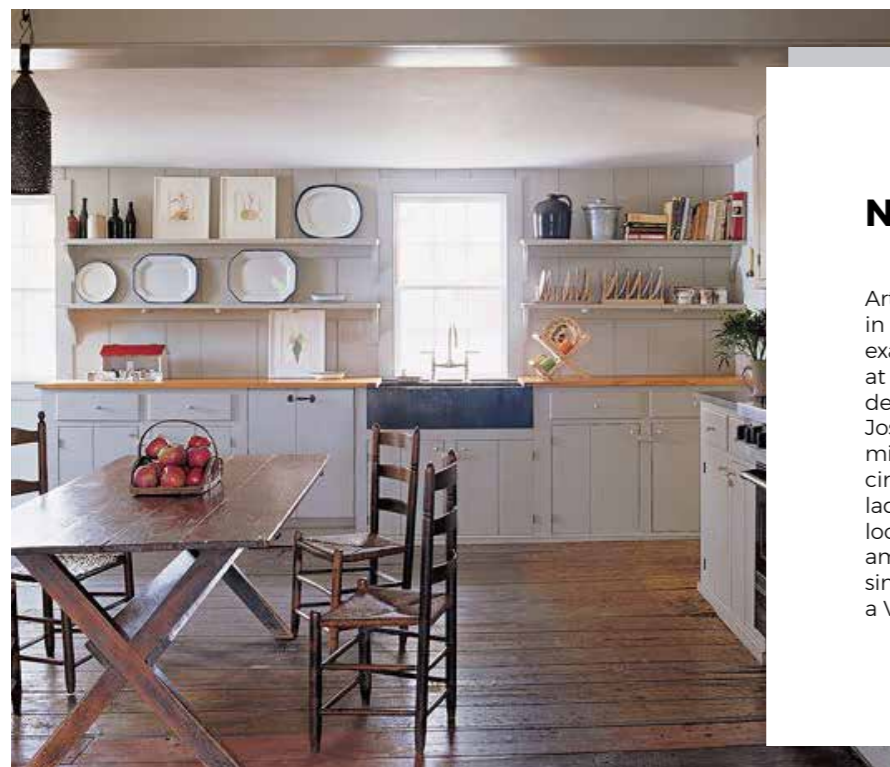


## KATIE BROWN'S

A hammered-steel island and pot racks by Enclume, a KitchenAid stove, and an arsenal of All-Clad cookware are some of the industrial-chic touches in the kitchen of Katie Brown's Bridgehampton, New York, weekend house; cabinetry made from salvaged wood, a wood countertop, and a floor of paved bricks help give the place its age-old look.

## OLD BARN

A neglected 110-year-old barn on Long Island was given a handsome renovation by homeowners Michel Botbol of Polo Ralph Lauren and Arthur Krystofiak. Pendant lights by Urban Archaeology are installed above a marble-top island in the kitchen, a brick-clad fireplace looks crisp and contemporary thanks to a coat of white paint, and the grandfather clock is a Swedish antique.



## NICOLA TYSON'S

Artist Nicola Tyson's farmhouse in New Paltz, New York, is an example of Shaker-like simplicity at its best. The cabinets — designed by architect James Joseph — were inspired by mid-19th-century farmhouses; a circa-1800 sawbuck table and ladder-back chairs made in 1810 look right at home alongside ample open shelving, a soapstone sink, wide-plank wood floors, and a Viking range.

## 17TH-CENTURY FARMHOUSE

In their 17th-century farmhouse in the South of France, Patrizia Maffeo and Dario Polenghi created lively backsplashes using antique tiles from Southern Italy. With a Louis XIV farm table, a skirted farm sink, and plenty of open shelving, it's the kind of kitchen you want to spend all day in.



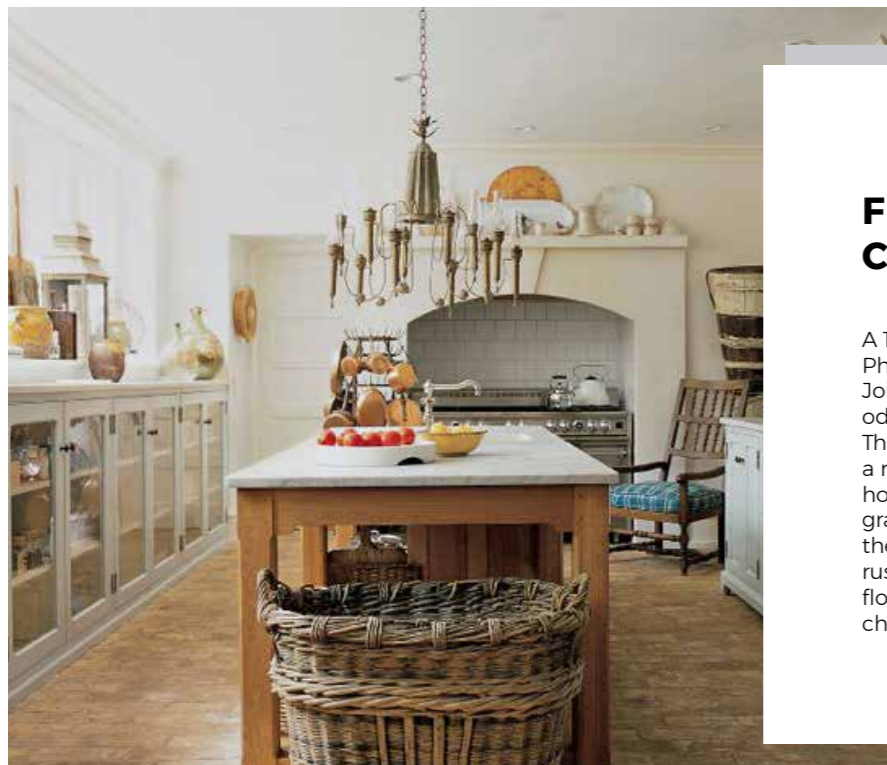


## VICTORIAN HOME

The Victorian home of designer Henri Quinta and his wife, Françoise, in Perpignan, France, has a kitchen packed with plenty of work surfaces on which to both cook and create flower arrangements; a zinc-top table takes center stage, and the concrete-and-wood sink units are a Quinta design.

## NEW YORK

In the kitchen of this 1760 farmhouse in Columbia County, New York, where photographer William Waldron lives with his family, antique stools surround a table by Anders Villum Jensen; the vintage factory lights are from CITE, and the sink and fittings are salvage finds.



## FRENCH COUNTRY

A 1912 Dutch Colonial in Philadelphia belonging to Keith Johnson and Glen Senk is an ode to French country chic. The marble-and-oak island is a replica of one at La Mirande hotel in Avignon, and the vintage grape-collecting basket is from the Champagne valley; other rustic elements include brick floor pavers and a whimsical chandelier.

## MALIBU HILLS

Interior designer Martyn Lawrence-Bullard infused the kitchen of this 1920s Malibu Hills, California, home with old-world ambience, choosing French lanterns from Ann-Morris Antiques, a plank-top table from Dan Marty Design, and a farm sink and fittings by Waterworks.





## AMY & TODD HASE'S

At Château du Jonquay, the 17th-century Normandy summer home of designers Amy and Todd Hase, vintage Empire-style dining chairs surround a vintner's tasting table in the kitchen; a vintage worktable serves as an island; open shelves display a collection of French porcelain.



## MONA NERENBERG'S

At Mona Nerenberg's Sag Harbor home, a vintage French artist's table serves as the kitchen island; the stove is by Wolf, the sink and fittings are by Waterworks, and the dishwasher is by GE; the sign on the ceiling beams is original to the house.

## GREY GARDENS

In the country kitchen of a Long Island home inspired by Grey Gardens, the chairs are by Palecek, the pot rack is by Urban Archaeology, the vintage tole chandelier is from Etsy, and the floors are oak.





## GREEK ISLANDS

In this Greek Islands vacation retreat, the kitchen countertops are poured concrete, and the doors, window frames, and custom cabinetry are all painted in a custom color.



## LOIRE VALLEY

The homeowners kept the original tile backsplash and flooring in the kitchen of this Loire Valley home. English mahogany chairs and a stylish chandelier, which was found at a flea market, give the space a lived-in feel.



## KEN FULK

Mid-century French armchairs are paired with a Hans Wegner table in the kitchen of this Ken Fulk-designed San Francisco home. The barstools are by Lucca Studio, the chandelier is by Vilhelm Lauritzen, and the kitchen island is by Bulthaup; the ovens are by Miele, the sink fittings are by Dornbracht, and the flooring is by Fox Marble.

The mid-20th century was a design renaissance for furniture, interiors and architecture. The sleek, distinctive style is beloved and has seen a major revival in past years – and we love the look. Travel back in time with these 27 rooms that exemplify the chic simplicity of mid-century modern design.

## A CONTEMPORARY CALIFORNIA RANCH



Portia de Rossi and Ellen DeGeneres have a ranch tucked away in the Santa Monica Mountains, filled to the brim with gorgeous design fixtures.

## FLEA MARKET FINDS

Inside Jason Rand's Manhattan apartment, a flea-market mirror hangs above a cabinet by Hans Wegner in the bedroom. The sconces by Tony Paul were bought on eBay and the large black-and-white print is by Elliott Puckette.



## SLEEK ACCENT PIECES

In a guest room of Paul Boschetto's California home, the vintage bed is upholstered in a Groundworks fabric and dressed in Barbara Martin linen. The wallpaper is a Kelly Wearstler design, the drawings are by Frank Gehry, the chair is by Donghia and the walnut side table is from Design Within Reach.





## DARK WOOD AGAINST WHITE WALLS

Fashion designer Andrew Gn's Paris apartment boasts a painting by Pan Jian above a Belgian stained-oak console in the living room. The circa-1898 armchairs are by Gustave Serrurier-Bovy, the blue ceramics are by Les Dalo and the lamp is by Didier Bazille.



## MID-CENTURY MINIMALISM

Also in Andrew Gn's Paris apartment, custom-made nightstands by Benoit Langlade, topped with 1970s lamps, flank the bed in the master bedroom. The coverlet is by Le Rideau de Paris and the armchair is Danish; the painting is by Myriam Boccara and the 1950s rug is Swedish.

## BOLD AND GRAPHIC 1950S STYLE

In a mid-century home in Morocco, a vintage Danish pendant light hangs above a dining table by Habitat, the 1950s chairs are by Ico Parisi, the painting is by Robert Schmid, and a wall is sheathed in Popham Design's Scarab tiles.



## PARISIAN MID- CENTURY STYLE

In the living room of fashion designer Andrew Gn's Paris apartment, 1950s wing chairs by Melchiorre Bega, upholstered in a Lelievre fabric, face armchairs by Emiel Veranneman and a cocktail table by Fredrik Schriever-Abeln, both from the 1960s.



## WOOD- PANELED KITCHEN

In the LA home of fashion designer Rozae Nichols, the kitchen features custom redwood cabinetry, a backsplash of penny tiles by Mission Tiles, an oven and dishwasher by Miele and sink fittings by Vola.



## SLEEK AND MINIMALIST

In this Palm Springs living room, you'll find vintage Barcelona chairs, back-to-back sofas by William Haines, an Arco lamp by Achille Castiglioni and a floor lamp by Dragonette; the wall is sheathed in Venetian plaster, the ceiling is cedar and the floors are poured-in-place terrazzo.



## TEXTURED BEDROOM

In the master bedroom of Academy Award winner Marisa Tomei's Manhattan apartment, a pair of 1940s chairs, purchased at auction, is covered in a fabric by Christopher Hyland, the bed is dressed with a throw and pillow by Rosemary Hallgarten, the brass lamp and Murano glass light fixture are vintage; the fireplace mantel is St. Laurent marble, the curtains are of a Kravet fabric and the walls are painted in Fine Paints of Europe's Black Plum.

## SUBDUED MODERN LINES



Jacques Adnet chairs from the 1950s surround the custom-made dining table in Giovanna Randall's New York City apartment. The chandelier is by Peter Mikic, and the walls are upholstered in an Old World Weavers damask; the painting is by Jackie Saccoccio, and the floor is white oak.



## L.A. MID-CENTURY

In the living area of Nichols and Murrough's Los Angeles house, the Jens Risom lounge chair and Florence Knoll slate-and-steel cocktail table are both vintage and the sofa is Swedish; the wall sculpture is by Jason Meadows, and a rug bought at a Marrakesh souk tops a Persian runner found at the Rose Bowl Flea Market.

## SLEEK AND SUNNY BEDROOM



The master bedroom in this airy Mexican home features a bed, dresser and side tables by Roche Bobois; the Eames chair and ottoman are by Herman Miller, the bedside lights are by FontanaArte and the wall is painted in Patagonia by Comex.

## OFF-BEAT DINING OASIS



In the kitchen of 1stdibs founder Michael Bruno's home, vintage Knoll chairs and a pair of armchairs by Jacques Quinet surround a 1970s table by Jules Wabbes that was designed for a conference room; the 19th-century light fixtures are Paris flea-market finds, the rooster sculpture came from Brussels, and floor is paved with marble tiles.

## MINIMALIST MOUNTAIN RETREAT



A ranch in the Santa Monica Mountains serves as the ideal retreat for Portia de Rossi and Ellen DeGeneres. In the living room of the property's main cabin, Number 8, a 1962 Fabricius & Kastholm chair faces a sofa covered in Belgian linen and a granite-top cocktail table, both from Brenda Antin.



## LIVING ROOM WITH A NEUTRAL PALETTE

In the living room of a house in Sag Harbor, New York, which was decorated by architect David Mann of MR Architecture + Decor, the custom sofa is covered in a Nobilis linen, the lounge chairs are by BassamFellows and the cocktail table is by Soraya Ltd.



## MID-CENTURY KITCHEN SPACE

This bohemian-chic New York apartment is full of mid-century touches. Hans Wegner chairs, purchased at auction, flank a table by Eero Saarinen from Design Within Reach, and the vintage pendant light is by Max Ingrand for FontanaArte.





## A MODERN TREE HOUSE

A family room's sofa and ottoman are by Ligne Roset, the Saarinen side table is by Knoll and the chairs are by Hans Wegner. The Arco lamp is by Flos, the pillows and rug are custom designs and the tapestry was created from a traditional Bhutanese man's robe.

## STYLISH LIBRARY

The library in this LA home has a chaise that was designed by Le Corbusier, Pierre Jeanneret and Charlotte Perriand; the shelving is by Alias.



## CONTEMPORARY FARM RESTORATION

An artist enlisted the help of a London architecture firm to help transform a dilapidated farm building. In the newly restored living area, you will find Gia Ponti chairs with a view of the River Stour.



## CLEAN AND VIBRANT DESIGN



White splattered tile lines the kitchen floor of London designer Colin Radcliffe's Notting Hill home. The cabinetry is custom made, the 1950s chandelier is FontanaArte and the 1970s barstools and the refrigerators are by Liebherr.



## COZY MODERN BEDROOM
